Have you traveled abroad and have **leftover foreign currency** from your trip? Are you helping clean out a friend or relative's home and found some spare change or bills? It can be a hassle, and sometimes impossible to convert money back to your domestic currency. Instead, donate it to Odylia and we will take care of it for you!

How Does it Work?

Odylia gathers foreign currency and returns it in-bulk, receiving a donation in US Dollars in exchange. Donating foreign currency doesn't just help Odylia, it helps in the re-circulation of foreign coins and reducing the number of coins needing to be made in the future. This decreases waste and increases the recycling process.

What Do I Do?

Gather your foreign currency and send it to Odylia:

1) You can drop your donation at one of our collection boxes.

2) Send your donation to us. You can use any shipping company you prefer. We do recommend tracking the shipment.

Find a sturdy box, put in your currency, and be sure to add packing with something like newspapers to prevent any coins from rattling, tape it up, being sure to seal it completely, then send to our address:
